Post Title: Cooking Skills Coordinator (part-time, 5 hours per week over 1- 2 days,

flexibility will be expected as course will need to be flexible with different client groups) for 12 months initially (possible extension depending on available ongoing funding) Hours of work between TBC but to be flexible with anticipated course – some weekend and early evening work may be

Main Duties: To develop, instigate and provide high quality cooking skills to a wide range

of adults with differing abilities and levels of confidence to engage with a new cooking skills training programme working to the highest level of food

safety and health and safety standards at all times.

Main Tasks and Responsibilities

The Cooking Skills Coordinator will take responsibility for the following tasks

- To make contact and develop a good relationship with local children's centres, colleges
 and other relevant organisations to offer a food cooking skills course that will meet the
 need of those who are struggling to prepare / provide nutritious meals for themselves or
 their families.
- To develop, instigate and continue to provide a high quality cooking skills course as laid out in the Main Duties section above.
- To ensure full completion of relevant record keeping as dictated by the organisation.
- To be responsible for all individuals whilst working alongside the other members of staff and volunteers in the organisation.
- To fully comply with all Health and Safety, COSHH, infection control and Food Hygiene regulations at all times
- To help and maintain a clean and tidy environment at all times in the café and preparation areas.
- To be an active and supportive team member, contributing in a constructive manner and treating all of Mustard Seed's team members and customers with fairness and courtesy

- To work in a way that is consistent with the Charities vision, including active participation in large events, out reaches and other promotions
- To provide excellent customer service, serving customers promptly, courteously and with a smile.
- Ensuring that any food and drink served is safe, of a consistently high standard and is well presented
- Ensure HACCP processes are followed and recorded as required.
- Any other tasks and duties as and when required.

The Cooking Skills Coordinator will have joint responsibility for the following tasks

- Positive promotion of Mustard Seed and the Community Cafe, to the Press, to the Public, to Local Businesses and other Charities, Community Organisations and Local Authorities, and the general public at large.
